



Music for Year 3

Exploring descriptive sounds – Animal Magic

- Developing children's ability to create descriptive sounds on the theme of animals.
- Compose and perform a short piece combining sounds, movement and words, question and response in musical form.
- Use stories to create sound pictures and sound effects.

Exploring rhythmic patterns

- Exploring rhythms and chants using repeated phrases.
- Creating simple patterns and performing in a group/individually.
- Using musical notation as a means of communicating.
- Using music from other times, cultures and countries.

Exploring arrangements

- Developing rhythmic patterns to accompany a song.
- Developing musical accompaniments, e.g. chords.
- Play and sing using rhythms and instruments together.
- Accents on musical contrast loud/soft/high/low, etc.
- Play a variety of melodies on tuned percussion instruments.
