



Music for Year 4

Exploring pentatonic scales

- Listen to music using a pentatonic scale.
- Create short melodies and accompaniments using the pentatonic scale.
- Composing to a specific given pattern.
- Using drones and ostinati as part of accompaniment.
- Play and sing pentatonic tunes in 2 parts.
- Music of China, East European folk music, music of Scotland, jazz, blues.

Exploring sound colours

- Exploring sound colours using descriptive music.
- Create, perform and listen to sound pictures.
- Moods and textures in music, e.g. tense, angry, calm, happy.
- Music for different purposes; wedding, funeral, march, war.

Exploring singing games

- Singing games and chants.
- Recognise playground rhymes and repeated phrases.
- How singing games have been created and passed on.
- Create own singing game and rhyme.
- Make a 4 line chant to a tune using a repeated phrase.
- Play simple melodies of keyboards and tuned percussion in 2 parts.
